

Fail widely (learn to make different kinds of mistakes)

- Failure to learn from failure
- Learning from the failure of others
- Want to put things right

DUSTGLORY

Know your besetting sins

- Character flaws
- Self awareness
- Conscious and unconscious biases
- 'Holy friendships'
